### **CSCMP's Pittsburgh Roundtable to Host Annual Competition for Supply Chain Students**

**Lombard, Illinois USA (March 15, 2011)**—The Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals' (CSCMP) Pittsburgh Roundtable will host its 25<sup>th</sup> annual supply chain student competition, the College Challenge, April 7, 2011, at the Sheraton Station Square Hotel in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

The competition was designed for undergraduate students enrolled in supply chain management programs at academic institutions throughout the country to test their industry knowledge. The event also provides the local business community with an opportunity to meet and recruit supply chain's future leaders.

"Celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> year of the College Challenge is an important milestone for CSCMP's Pittsburgh Roundtable," said Lori Molinari, Pittsburgh Roundtable president. The evening will conclude with the finalists competing for the CSCMP College Challenge champion title, "Best of the Best," and trophy.

Competing academic institutions include The University of Akron, Duquesne University, Niagara University, Shippensburg University, the University of North Texas, and Wayne State University.
