- This roundtable board committee chair positon is focused on collaborating with the VP of Programs in the development of events to serve students and Young Professionals entering the supply chain discipline.
- Collaborate with the Education Chair to build awareness and develop relationships with local schools providing supply chain curriculum.
- Collaborate with roundtable officers to assist in creating vested relationships with local Young Professional members and Student members to engage and support their career endeavors
- Advocate on behalf of CSCMP membership and its importance throughout the member lifecycle.
